Day 1 Arrival Delhi

Warm welcome with fresh flower garlands, Day 9 In Khajuraho your room is available for immediate Early morning game-drive in Panna Tiger occupancy.

Day 2 Delhi - Ranthambhore

Travel by train to Ranthambhore, famous for the wildlife sanctuary, which is said to have the India's friendliest Tigers and considered to be the best place in the world to photograph the Day 10 Khajuraho - Bandhavgarh tiger in its natural habitat. Overnight Hotel.

Day 3 In Ranthambhore

On morning and late afternoon game excursions, you are likely to see Nilgai (blue bull), barking deer and sloth bear and perhaps elusive Royal Bengal tiger. Overnight Hotel.

Day 4 In Ranthambhore

Today you may wish to go for game excursions in the park or can go for a sightseeing tour of Ranthambhore Fort and Mansarovar Lake. Overnight Hotel.

Day 5 Ranthambhore - Bharatpur

Travel to Bharatpur, a home to an astonishing Day 13 Bandhavgarh - Kanha range of flora and fauna. An abundance of birdlife is found here, including the open-bill and painted stork, egret, darter, white ibis, valley and thick forest, rich in birdlife with spoonbill, grey heron, Sarus crane, cormorant, over 300 different species. It is famous for migratory geese, duck, rosy pelican and the rare Siberian crane. Overnight Hotel.

Day 6 In Bharatpur

Have a completely rewarding experience of seeing an overwhelming range of birds during the rickshaw ride into the bird sanctuary. Evening rickshaw ride in the local market of the city. Overnight Hotel.

Day 7 Bharatpur - Agra

Journey to the city of Taj, Agra en route visit the evocative city of Fatehpur Sikri, built by Emperor Akbar as his capital and palace in the late 16th century, it is a veritable fairytale city built of red sandstone, and its « ruins » are in Day 17 Nagpur - Delhi pristine condition. Post lunch we explore the Fly back to Delhi. Evening dinner at popular imposing Agra Fort, built of red sandstone and at sunset. This 17th century, white marble -

mausoleum was built by Emperor Shah Jehan Day 17 Delhi - Corbett to enshrine the mortal remains of his Queen Travel by road to Corbett national park - lies Mumtaz Mahal. Overnight Hotel.

Day 8 Agra - Jhansi - Orchha - Khajuraho

Morning we travel by train to Jhansi, where Day 18 In Corbett we disembark and visit the fortified town of Morning and evening jeep safari in the park, Orchha and continue our drive to Khajuraho, great opportunity for viewing wildlife, the legendary temples of Khajuraho built in especially the tiger in its natural habitat. the 9th & 10th century are an incomparable Visit one of the best wildlife libraries of experience. Reserve. Later we visit the Eastern & Western group exquisite 10th century temples of Khajuraho. Evening witness "sound and light show" in the western group of temples. Overnight Hotel.

A drive today takes us to Bandhavgarh National Park, is a premier wildlife preserve in the Vindhya mountain range of Central India. This National Park offers excellent game viewing, with the possibility of sighting tiger, leopard, gaur, nilgai, wild boar and sloth bear. Overnight Hotel.

Day 11 In Bandhavgarh

Morning and late afternoon game viewing in the park. Overnight Hotel

Day 12 In Bandhavgarh

As day 11

Drive to Kanha National Park, a « Project Tiger » reserve which covers a wide area of barasingha (swamp deer), blackbuck, jackals, leopard and, especially tiger. Overnight Hotel

Day 14 In Kanha

Morning and evening jungle visits for tiger tracking, nature watch or birding. Overnight

Day 15 In Kanha

As day 14

Day 16 Kanha - Nagpur

We travel by road to Nagpur. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight Hotel.
